





As a designer it is important to take a step into the unknown, A step which reflects the important issues of the project at an abstract level, without getting entangled with the nitty-gritty. Through the process of superimposing other issues like Site, Climate, Resources, Functionality, Time, art craft etc. the diagram slowly comes to reality. The sequence in which you superimpose, governs the final built form. I would be showing examples of this process in my students' and my own work.

Placements Summary - Exit Exhibition 2024


