3. The Context [20 Words]

In the ninth semester of final year B.Arch, PVPCoA's 'Practical Training' module offers broader exposure, fostering individual growth beyond hometown comfort zones, focusing on developing essential life skills and professional competencies.

4. The Practice [50 Words]

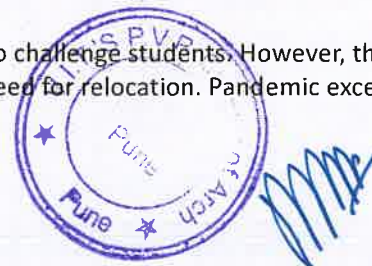
- PVPCoA mandates students to intern in cities outside their home state for cultural exposure, fostering adaptability and broadening horizons.
- Students are EXPECTED to work for a minimum of SIX CONTINUOUS CALENDAR MONTHS in the same office so that working methodologies of the office can be sufficiently absorbed and gain adequate experience.

5. Evidence of Success [40 Words]

PVPCoA students interned in top offices globally, with rigorous record-keeping ensuring professional integrity. Experiences shared by final year students annually during 'Journey of Practical Training' foster knowledge exchange among students, enriched by the college library's collection of drawings and documents.

6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required [30 Words]

College mandates practical training in various cities outside Maharashtra to challenge students. However, there are instances where students may struggle to adjust to a new city, leading to the need for relocation. Pandemic exception allowed training in hometowns during 2020-2022.

1. Title of the Practice

'Architectural Quotient' [AQ] – Pune's inter-college Quiz Competition

2. Objectives of the Practice [20 Words]

- Enhance Pune architecture students' Architectural Trivia knowledge.
- Provide exposure to diverse architectural facets.
- Empower students with knowledge beyond the syllabus.

3. The Context [20 Words]

The vision is to elevate the Architectural Fraternity's quizzing standard and establish Pune as an Architectural Quiz Hub, thus preparing them for the Grand National Quiz, 'ARCHUMEN' organized by Ethos.

4. The Practice [50 Words]

PVPCoA has been hosting the "Architectural Quotient (AQ)" inter-collegiate quiz in Pune since 2008. The event attracts teams of B.Arch. students who register either beforehand or on the spot. A qualifying round precedes the main quiz, where top six teams engage in subject-specific rounds encompassing architectural topics and Pune city.

5. Evidence of Success [40 Words]

In 2008, AQ allowed two teams per college, with Sinhgad College of Architecture claiming victory. Since 2011, PVPCoA has continued hosting AQ, fostering a vibrant quizzing culture. This has led PVPCoA teams to win the national quiz "ARCHUMEN" four times.

6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required [30 Words]

In 2020 and 2021, COVID-19 deferred AQ Quiz, prompting PVPCoA's shift to digital. "AQ 2020 – Level Up Under Lockdown!" was a week-long online architectural quiz on Instagram with unique themes.



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PVPCoA's commitment to innovation and continuous improvement in education is evident through the implementation of various best practices.

- **Best Practice One: Practical training** where our students necessarily join offices in cities outside Maharashtra which gives them an opportunity to go out of their comfort zone. This gives them exposure to different cultures and working environments in other regions including various aspects like climate, lifestyle, food habits, people & festivals, local architecture, etc.
- **Best Practice Two: "AQ" (Architectural Quotient)** an endeavor conceived to elevate the quizzing standard of the Architectural Fraternity in Pune as an Architectural Quiz Hub, thus preparing them for the Grand National Quiz, 'ARCHUMEN' organized by Ethos.

Both the above two practices are distinctive part of the college identity.

Here's an overview of some more Events & Initiatives that have been successfully implemented over the years and can very well qualify as Best Practices.

Flagship Events of PVPCoA:

- **"ACARA" (Asian Contest of Architectural Rookie's Award)** hosted by our college is an international contest for students of Architecture open for ongoing 4th-year students to present their 3rd Year B. Arch design. It is held every year to contribute to architectural education and establish rich networking associated with modern architecture in Asia from which two students represent India at the Asian level.
- **"Shearforce"** is an INTERCOLLEGIATE SPORTS TOURNAMENT hosted with an intention of strengthening fraternal bonds amongst the Architectural colleges primarily from the state of Maharashtra.
- **"Insight"**, an exhibition to display the work done in academics by the students is one of its kind in Maharashtra that is open year-round.
- **"Thesis Jury"**, a jury comprising of a 3-panel member team of 2 external jurors (one within Pune and the other outside Pune) accompanied by the internal guide organized one month prior to The SPPU viva to impart thesis students a wide exposure, comments and time for retrospection.
- **"Exit exhibition"** a platform for each and every final year student to put up their work in the public domain and interact with professionals and young aspirants for the field of architecture.

Other Initiatives:

- **"Healthy Body"** to improve the energy levels and health of the students and a **"Healthy mind"** to shape the lives of students and advice students at crucial turning points in their lives thereby holistically helping the students.
- **"Clean Campus. Green Campus."** focuses on environment sustainability for reducing the environmental impact of the existing functional campus whether it is to keep carbon emissions low by promoting bus facility or developing an awareness of waste management, water management, energy management, and ecosystem through initiatives in the form of workshops at institute level.

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1.0] BEST PRACTICE ONE: 'Practical Training'

Objectives of the Practice:

- Develop ability of students to work out of their comfort zone.
- Exposure to different cultures and working environments.

As per the prevailing syllabus of the affiliated University, there is a module for 'Practical Training' in the Ninth semester of Final year B. Arch. Under this module, PVPCoA plans to give its students 'Wider Exposure' and 'Developing individual abilities and life skills' to sustain in places 'Beyond their Comfort Zone' of the hometown where the student belongs.

PVPCoA has formulated following POLICIES for the module of "PRACTICAL TRAINING": Students must join offices in various cities, especially out of the home state of College and Student's hometown which gives them an opportunity to go out of their comfort zone to be exposed to different cultures and working environments in other regions including aspects like varied Climate, lifestyle, food habits, people, festivals, etc. It also exposes students to architecture as a response to the local climate & culture. Students are also expected to work for a minimum period of six continuous calendar months in the same office so that working methodologies of the office could be sufficiently absorbed and students can gain adequate experience.

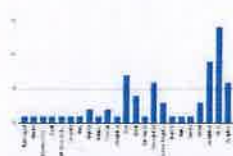
Since last decade, our students have worked in best of the offices in various cities like Delhi, Ahmadabad, Bengaluru, Puducherry, Chennai, Jammu, Kolkata, Kochi, etc in India, and cities in east Asia like Ho Chi Minh City in Vietnam, Colombo in Sri Lanka and few cities in Gulf, Europe & Africa. PVPCoA has developed a comprehensive framework for following up with the trainee students throughout their training period in the form of a Logbook, Daily work diary, joining report, monthly progress reports, various feedback forms, etc, thus remaining in constant contact with professional offices.

Apart from above documents, students also submit a comprehensive portfolio of the work done in office, which is retained in our college library. Over the years, the college library can boast of drawings & documents from best of the offices in India & abroad, which remain as copyright of the offices that ensures the professional drawings are not copied or taken out of the library premises without permission from the office the drawings belong to. Practical Training team also maintains detailed contact information of students and various professional offices they have interned with.

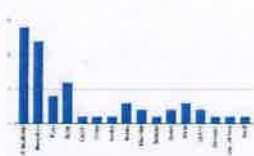
Experiences of practical training are shared by trainee students with junior students in 3rd and 4th year through a special program - 'Journey of Practical Training', which is organized by the students' body of the college each year on 26th January.

College policy for Practical Training is mandatory that students must join offices in varied cities, especially out of Maharashtra which gives them an opportunity to go out of their comfort zone. Nevertheless, sometimes we encounter problem of a certain student not being able to adjust to new city due to which we relocate them. The pandemic duration (2020-2021 to 2021-2022) being an exception, this policy was relaxed and students were allowed to do training in their hometowns as well.

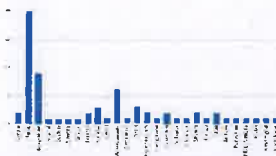
PRACTICAL TRAINING YEAR WISE PLACEMENT FOR PAST 5 ACADEMIC YEARS :



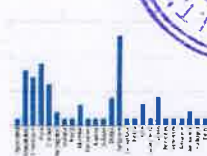
ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-2020



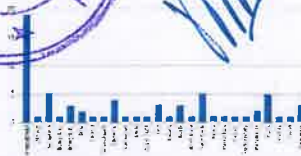
ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-2021

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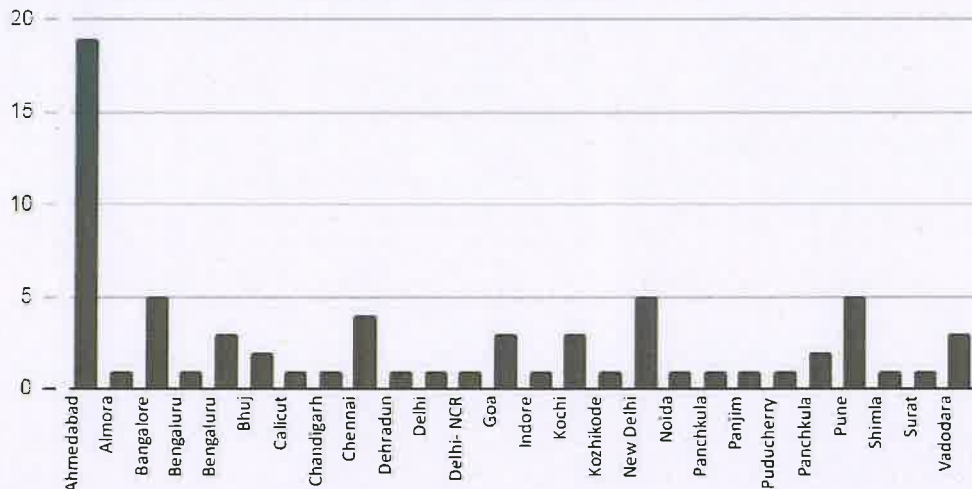

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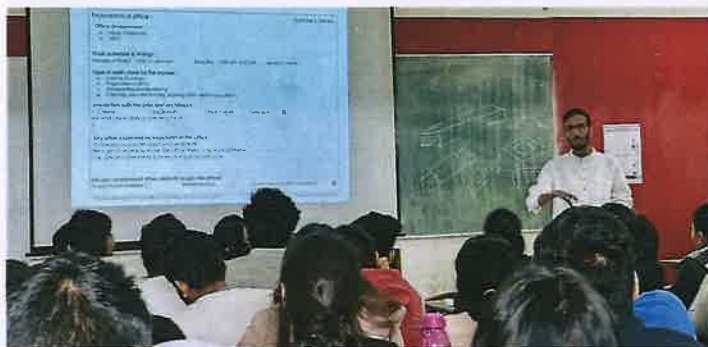

Objectives of the Practice:

The vision is to elevate the Architectural Fraternity's quizzing standard and establish Pune as an Architectural Quiz Hub, thus preparing them for the Grand National Quiz, 'ARCHUMEN' organized by Ethos.

Every year, PVPCoA hosts "Architectural Quotient (AQ)", an inter-collegiate quiz, among colleges of Architecture affiliated with Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) and other universities, as a platform to showcase the best and most knowledgeable minds in the city of Pune. This exciting endeavor was established by PVPCoA in 2008. It was launched to enable students from all architectural colleges in Pune to - engage in a friendly battle of wits, test their Architectural knowledge, and put it to compete with teams from other colleges.

The format of the Quiz is:

- Students of B.Arch. register in teams of two members through a Google form OR 'on-the-spot' registrations on the day of the quiz.
- A Qualifying Round comprising 15-20 objective questions to be solved by all registered teams in 15 minutes.
- Top 6 shortlisted teams participate in Main Quiz rounds with rule being: Not more than 2 teams per college.
- Main quiz comprises 8 rounds with subject-specific questions 'From the classroom' and 'Pune City' specific questions.

In 2008, two teams from every college were allowed in the qualifying round, and six teams from six prominent colleges competed in the final showdown. Sinhgad College of Architecture (SCOA), Pune emerged as the winner.

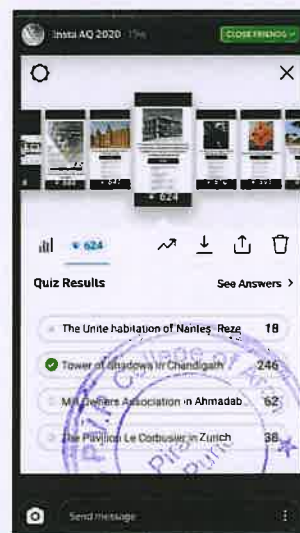
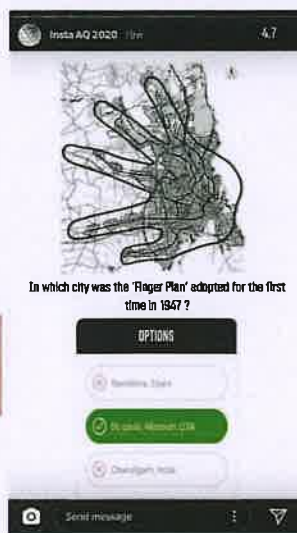
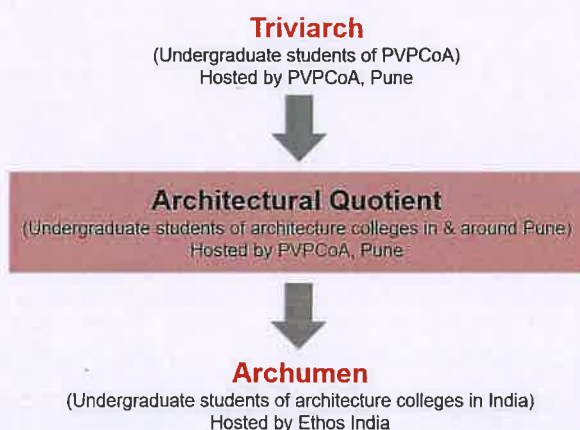
