Criteria 4:

- Increase the budget for infrastructure augmentation.
- Add common rooms.

Criteria 5:

- Register the college alumni association.
- Ensure 5th-year students register with the alumni association before leaving.

Criteria 6:

- Include Team 6 members in IQAC.
- Prepare policy documents for increment, service rules, and leaves etc.

Criteria 7:

- Address issues related to barrier-free access.
- Implement e-waste segregation and disposal measures.

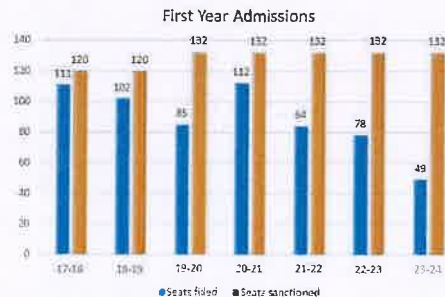

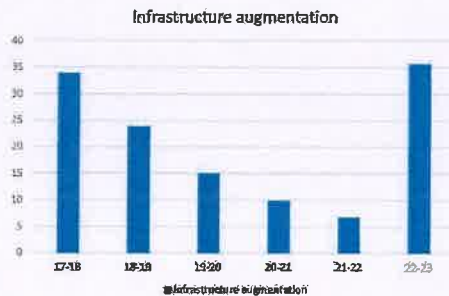
- Number of faculty members with PhD has to gradually increase.

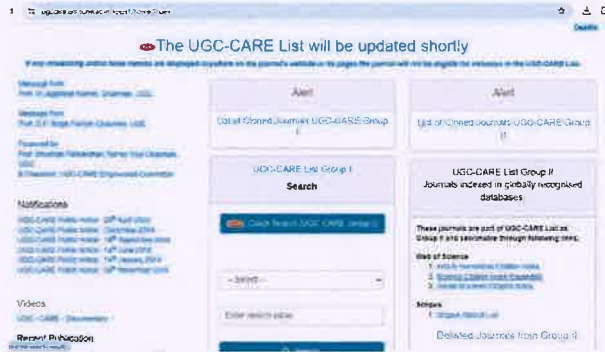

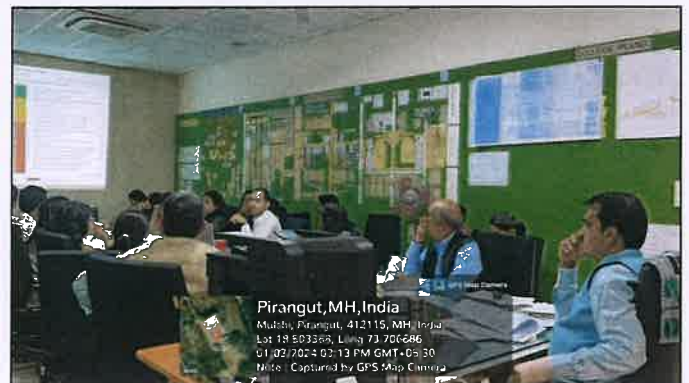
